A tree tracing Doodsons in Oldham on the 1911 census

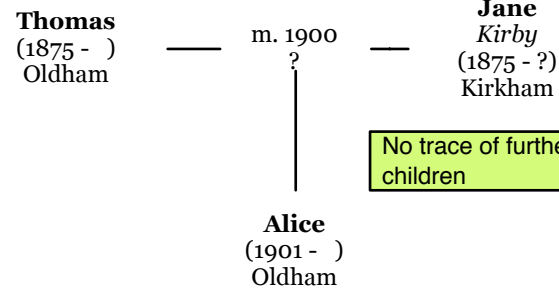
## Family trees prepared by Mike Doodson

Sources of information: Census returns for 1841-1911 plus Births Marriages and Deaths records

Entries in **bold** type - given (Christian) names  
 Entries in *italic* type - spouse surnames



No definitive trace prior to 1901 census  
**1901**: at 21 Chapman Street, Oldham  
**1911**: at 112 Cranbrooke Street, Oldham



No trace of further children

No definitive trace prior to 1891  
**1891**: lodging at Beeson Brickworks, Oldham. - Blacksmith. Recorded as born in Bury.  
**1901**: boarding at "Model" Castle Street, Oldham. - carter. Recorded as born in Bury  
**1911**: at Jagers Working Mens Home, Beever Street. - Blacksmith striker. Described as being single

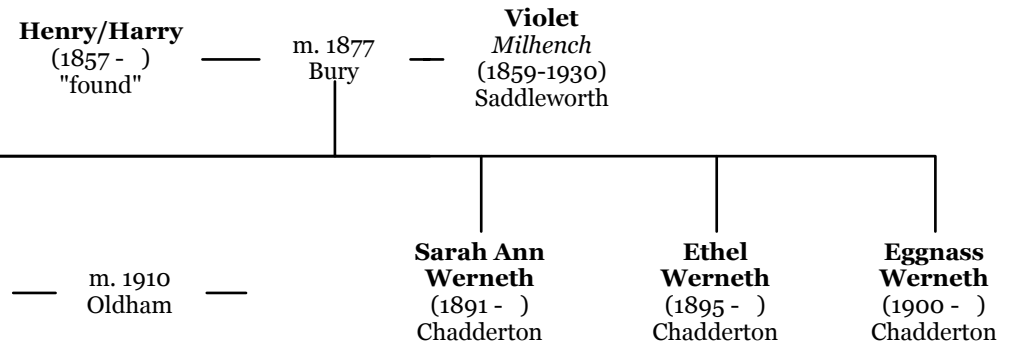
**John** (1851 - ) Oldham

No definitive trace prior to 1911  
**1911**: boarding at 10 Dalton Street, Chadderton

**Mary Ann** (1884 - ) Heywood

**Unlinked and fragmented**  
 Although there are a few distinct family groups on these trees these are unlinked to other major trees - no provable links have been found ... yet.

No trace of Henry prior to 1881 census  
**1881**: Henry and family at 35 Ogden Street, Chadderton  
**1891**: at 562 Middleton Road, Chadderton  
**1901**: at 598 Middleton Road Chadderton.  
**1911**: at 16 Taylor Street, Chadderton.  
 Henry recorded as Harry - invalid for 9 years. All members of family (including Violet) recorded as having middle name Werneth. Harry's birth place recorded as "not know - found". Sarah Ann shown as visitor, with married surname

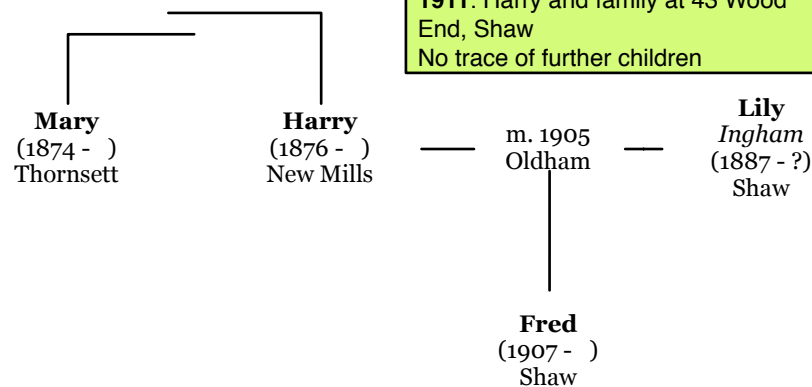


John married either Harriet Ann Dorchester or Selina Hammonds

Sarah married Bernard Nailous/ Nailors in 1910.

1901: Egna H  
 1911: Eggness Werneth

**Not able to trace Mary or Harry prior to their parents**  
**1881**: Harry as step-son of John and Ann Howe at Thornset, New Mills. Recorded as born in Thornset, Derbyshire. Living next door was Mary Doodson b1874, granddaughter of William Liddiard.  
**1891**: Harry and Mary living with Howe family at Thornset. Both described as step-children



1901: no trace of Harry  
 1911: Harry and family at 43 Wood End, Shaw  
 No trace of further children
