A set of trees linking all Doodsons who live or have lived in Devon and/or Cornwall

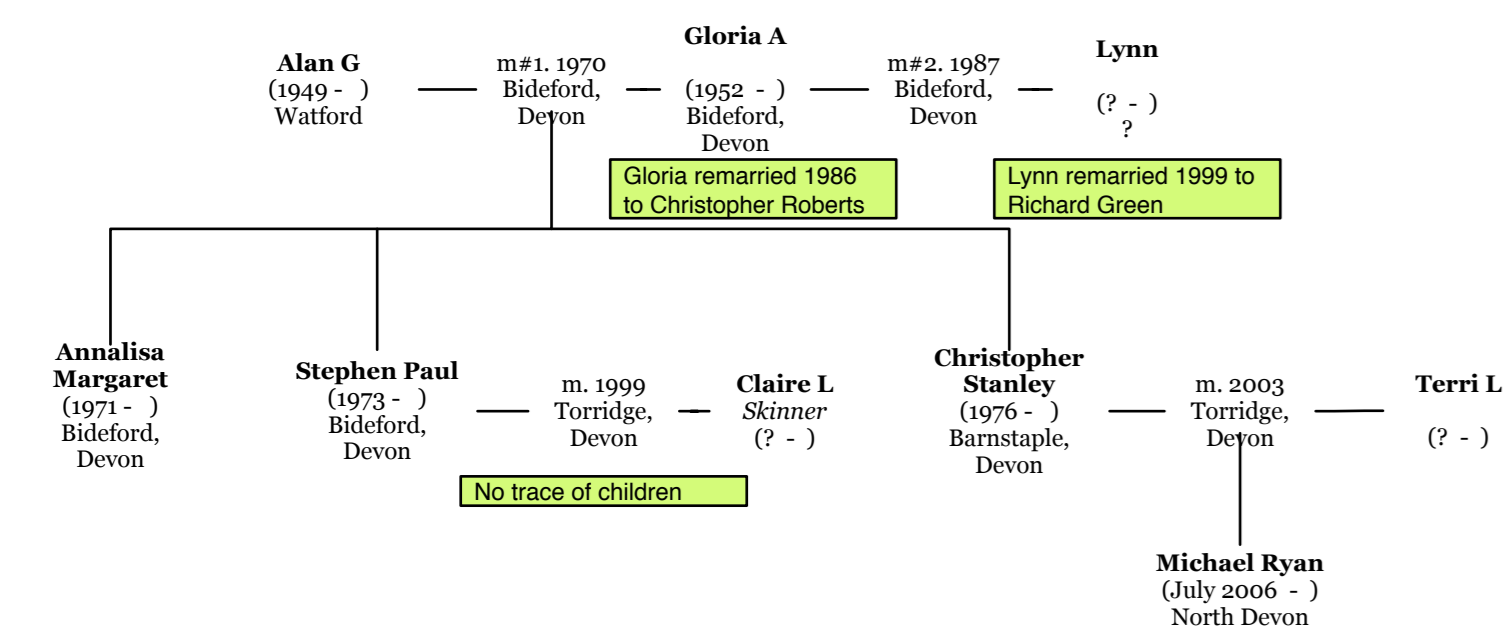

Sources of information: Census returns for 1841-1911 plus Births Marriages and Deaths records Updated August 2011 with additional 1911 links. Minor amendments Oct 2011 and Jan 2012 Added significant additional relatives to "Albert Doodson" tree, additional marriage information prior to January 2014 the right hand side of the "Ernest Doodson" tree (i.e. excluding William and Mary Ann's branch) was shown in the "unmatched from 1911 census" section of the web site. New evidence (thanks to Michele Covanni) allowed the two separate trees to be connected. Link between John William Doodson (b. 1878) and one of the previously unlinked Australian trees thanks to encouragement from Lyn Foster and Doug Doodson

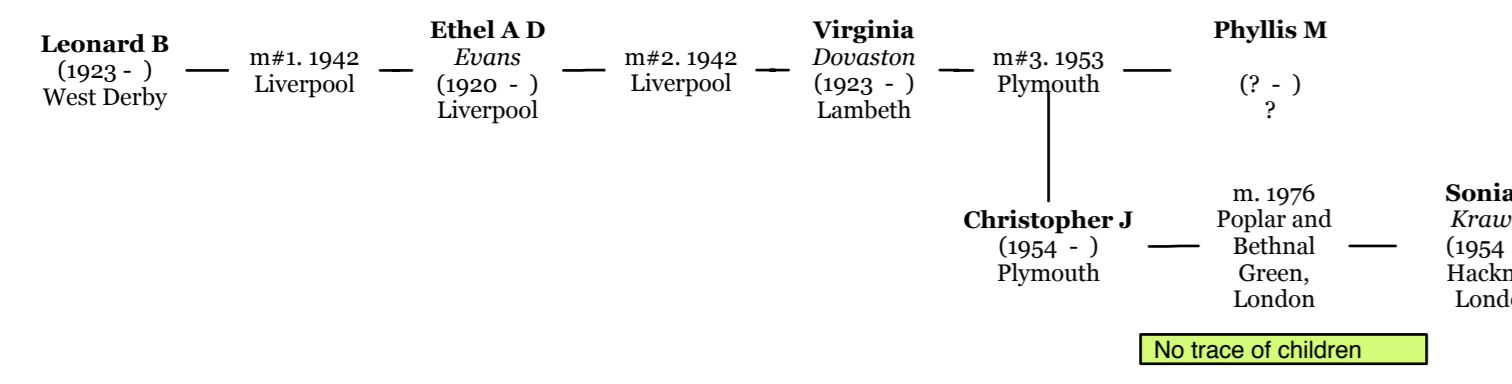
Entries in bold type - given (Christian) names
Entries in italic type - spouse surnames



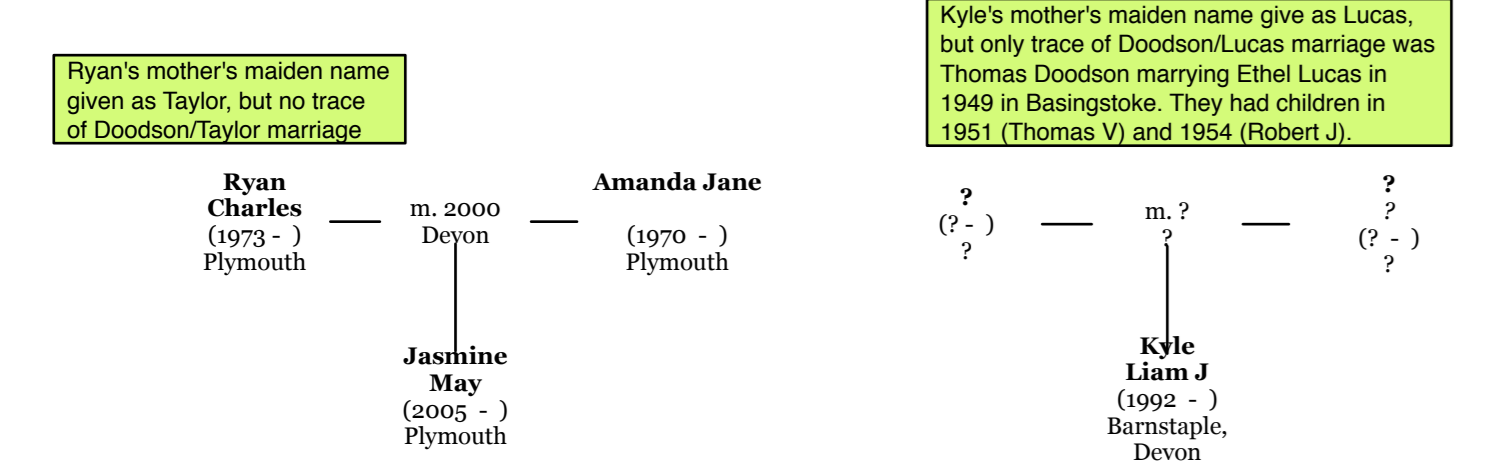
See Thelwall and Lydiate family tree



See Toxteth Park/Liverpool family tree

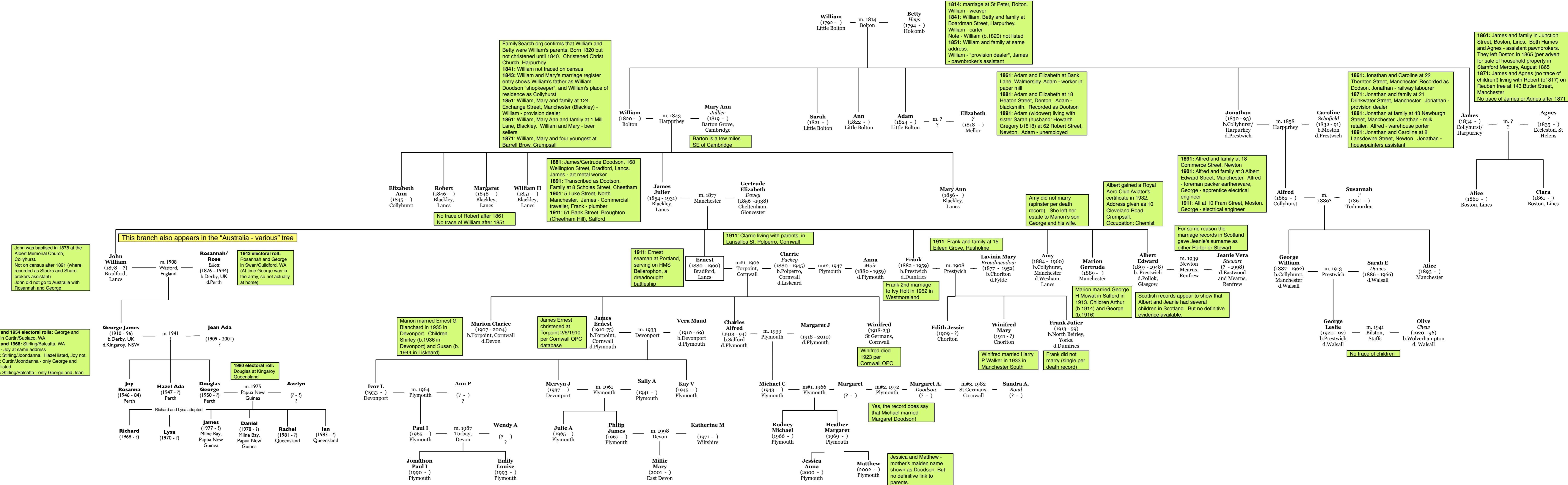

Ernest Doodson goes to Cornwall

Ernest (b1882) was in Cornwall in 1911 during his time in the Navy. While there he married a local girl, Clarrie Puckey



John was baptised in 1878 at the Albert Memorial Church, Collyhurst. Not on census after 1891 (where recorded as Stocks and Share brokers assistant) John did not go to Australia with Rosannah and George

This branch also appears in the "Australia - various" tree

1943 electoral roll: Rosannah and George in Swan/Guildford, WA (At time George was in the army, so not actually at home)

1949 and 1954 electoral rolls: George and Jean in Curtin/Subiaco, WA 1963 and 1968: Stirling/Balcatta, WA 1968 - Joy at same address 1972: Stirling/Joondanna. Hazel listed, Joy not. 1977: Curtin/Joondanna - only George and Jean listed 1980: Stirling/Balcatta - only George and Jean

1980 electoral roll: Douglas at Kingaroy Queensland

Yes, the record does say that Michael married Margaret Doodson!

Jessica and Matthew - mother's maiden name shown as Doodson. But no definitive link to parents.

FamilySearch.org confirms that William and Betty were William's parents. Born 1820 but not christened until 1840. Christened Christ Church, Harpurhey 1841: William not traced on census 1843: William and Mary's marriage register entry shows William's father as William Doodson "shopkeeper", and William's place of residence as Collyhurst 1851: William, Mary and family at 124 Exchange Street, Manchester (Blackley) - William - provision dealer 1861: William, Mary Ann and family at 1 Mill Lane, Blackley. William and Mary - beer sellers 1871: William, Mary and four youngest at Barrell Brow, Crumpsall

1814: marriage at St Peter, Bolton. William - weaver 1841: William, Betty and family at Boardman Street, Harpurhey. William - carter Note - William (b.1820) not listed 1851: William and family at same address. William - "provision dealer", James - pawnbroker's assistant

1861: Adam and Elizabeth at Bank Lane, Walmersey. Adam - worker in paper mill 1881: Adam and Elizabeth at 18 Heaton Street, Denton. Adam - blacksmith. Recorded as Doodson 1891: Sarah (widower) living with sister Sarah (husband: Howarth Gregory b1818) at 62 Robert Street, Newton. Adam - unemployed

1861: James and family in Junction Street, Boston, Lincs. Both Harries and Agnes - assistant pawnbrokers. They left Boston in 1865 (per advert for sale of household property in Stamford Mercury, August 1865 1871: James and Agnes (no trace of children) living with Robert (b1817) on Reuben tree at 143 Butler Street, Manchester No trace of James or Agnes after 1871

1861: Jonathan and Caroline at 22 Thornton Street, Manchester. Recorded as Dodson. Jonathan - railway labourer 1871: Jonathan and family at 21 Drinkwater Street, Manchester. Jonathan - provision dealer 1881: Jonathan at family at 43 Newburgh Street, Manchester. Jonathan - milk retailer. Alfred - warehouse porter 1891: Jonathan and Caroline at 8 Lansdowne Street, Newton. Jonathan - housepainters assistant

1891: Alfred and family at 18 Commerce Street, Newton 1901: Alfred and family at 3 Albert Edward Street, Manchester. Alfred - foreman packer earthenware, George - apprentice electrical engineer 1911: All at 10 Fram Street, Moston. George - electrical engineer

Amy did not marry (spinster per death record). She left her estate to Marion's son George and his wife.

Albert gained a Royal Aero Club Aviator's certificate in 1932. Address given as 10 Cleveland Road, Crumpsall. Occupation: Chemist

For some reason the marriage records in Scotland gave Jeanie's surname as either Porter or Stewart

1881: James/Gertrude Doodson, 168 Wellington Street, Bradford, Lincs. James - art metal worker 1891: Transcribed as Doodson. Family at 8 Scholes Street, Cheetham 1901: 5 Luke Street, North Manchester. James - Commercial traveller, Frank - plumber 1911: 51 Bank Street, Broughton (Cheetham Hill), Salford

No trace of Robert after 1861
No trace of William after 1851

1911: Ernest seaman at Portland, serving on HMS Bellerophon, a dreadnought battleship

1911: Clarrie living with parents, in Lansallos St, Polperro, Cornwall

1911: Frank and family at 15 Eileen Grove, Rusholme

Marion married Ernest G Blanchard in 1935 in Devonport. Children Shirley (b.1936 in Devonport) and Susan (b. 1944 in Liskeard)

Scottish records appear to show that Albert and Jeanie had several children in Scotland. But no definitive evidence available.

No trace of children

Winfred died 1923 per Cornwall OPC

Winfred married Harry P Walker in 1933 in Manchester South

Frank did not marry (single per death record)
