


Family tree c.1700 to present day
Pilkington, Leigh and Radcliffe

Family tree prepared by Mike Doodson
From census and other historical record information, including research by Noreen Doodson, with additional information from Simon Doodson.

Original tree constructed November 2007, Revisions March 2011, August 2011 (additional links to 1911 census), minor updates Oct/Nov 2011. Info from War Graves Jan 2012, Updated current generations July 2013, additions to descendants of Peter (b.1803) Jan 2014, Further additions to descendants of John (b.1825) and Sarah Ann (b.1823), Feb. 2014, Additions to reflect emigration to Australia by Alan Doodson, Jan 2016, additions/amendments to various BMD dates May 2016

Note that male lines that do not continue could not be traced at time of research. It is possible that there were descendants either outside the UK or with different surnames (e.g. changed spelling)

Frank had already emigrated to Canada prior to WW1. He joined the Canadian Over-Sea Expeditionary Force in 1914 in Alberta. He married Dorothy in York before he returned to Canada. Frank returned to Canada in 1919, still in the forces. First record of Dorothy and Frank being in Canada together in 1920 when they returned to England together. Frank, Dorothy and Betty returned to the UK in 1939. Frank emigrated to Australia (date not found) living in Queensland in 1972.

Betty Married William M Black in 1944 in Edmonston, Middlesex. Daughter Cora D. E. Black (b.1948, Scarborough). Betty re-married to John F Edgcomb in 1953 in Scarborough, Yorks.

1891: William and Elizabeth married at St Mark, Worsley
1891: William and Elizabeth at 20 Vickers Hall Lane, Worsley, William - power loom overcorder
1901: at 14 Leigh Road, Worsley
1911: no trace of Sarah after 1911

1911: Cameron and Sarah at 19 William Street, Colne
1912 - Cameron travelled to New York, not with Sarah
Cameron was reported in newspaper reports as being secretary of the General Union of Warp Dressers in Sept 1932, and as being a Socialist County Councillor in Colne in January 1949

Malcolm's death was registered in Oldham despite James and Marcella living in Colne in 1892

1901: Jane (widow) living with sister Mary Geldard in Chorley. No children

No record of James after 1871
